à Fun Christmas Safety Precautions

Fire Safety "Don't Roast the House Like Chestnuts"

- Water your tree so it doesn't turn into a giant holiday torch.
- Keep candles away from curtains, pets, kids... basically anything flammable.
- Check your lights—if they look sketchy, they probably *are*.
- Turn off decorations before bed. Your house doesn't need to party all night.

- Avoid tinsel if you have pets—dogs think it's spaghetti... it is not.
- Batteries, small toys, and tiny decorations = choking hazards for both kids and curious pets.

Tood Safety "Protect the Feast"

- Don't leave food out too long unless you want to start your own bacteria farm.
- Cook meat thoroughly—no one wants to experience "The Revenge of the Undercooked Turkey."
- Wash hands often... especially after touching raw poultry or sticky candy canes.

Travel Safety "Sleigh Responsibly"

- Don't drink and sleigh—use a designated driver.

- Keep an emergency kit in the car just in case winter decides to be dramatic.
